Community Safety Update - Platt Fields Park

We are aware that there have been a small number of incidents in and around Platt Fields Park this year. In response, we want to reassure the community that we are working closely with Greater Manchester Police (GMP) on this matter. We have also requested additional visible patrols by our Security Colleagues to provide reassurance to all park users.

We are also planning to arrange a Women and Girls Safety Session at the Lakeside Centre. This session will provide a space to share concerns, learn about safety resources, and hear directly from community safety professionals.

We continue to work in close partnership with colleagues from Community Safety and GMP, and we remain committed to doing everything we can to support a safe and welcoming environment for everyone.

We would also encourage everyone to download the **WalkSafe+ app**, this app was launched by the City Council recently and is a free personal safety tool designed to help you feel more secure when out and about.

Key features include:

- **HomeSafe**: Set a destination and ETA. If you don't arrive on time, your trusted contacts will be notified.
- WalkSafe: Share your live location with friends in real-time.
- **Follow Me**: Ideal for walks or exercise—share your location without a set destination and choose who can see it.
- **SOS Button**: If you feel unsafe, press the SOS button to instantly share your location with your contacts.
- Download WalkSafe+ from the App Store or Google Play Store.
